In order to assist Clubs and individuals who may want to consider competing in more than one event at this years Ryde Rowing Club Regatta please see below for the likely order/running order of events. <u>This is subject to change depending on entries received</u> but can be used as a guideline when planning which events a Club/individual wants to enter to see if it is practical and so that Captains can ensure that they have the appropriate equipment available.

In planning your entries you should allow between ten and fifteen minutes for each race but note that the restriction on the time available at Ryde means that, while boat/crew/cox changes will be accommodated if possible no guarantees that the starters will be able to wait can be given and crews/individuals entering more than one race do so entirely at their own risk and starts will not be delayed if crews are late getting afloat. It should also be noted that the right is reserved to amalgamate heats or combine finals if scratching's justify. Crews must therefore be prepared to row at the published time of the first heat of the event for which they are entered, or within 15 minutes notice of a change in timing.

*Ryde R. C. statement – agreed at H&D AGM, 9/3/13. You will be aware that the tidal conditions and sandbank at Ryde restrict the Regatta to around four and a half hours - about 22 events - and that we impose entry restrictions on small boat events as a result. In the past few years this has allowed us to accommodate heats in just one event - usually the Men's Novice Fours. Following an increase in new members at most clubs there is a possibility of a significantly higher than usual entry in both the Men's & Ladies Novice Fours events which may require heats in both these events. This can probably only be accommodated by dropping some of the small boat events. Therefore, the Associations has agreed that, if Heats are required in both the Men's and Ladies Novice Fours event we will drop some of the small boats events - starting, subject to entries received, with the Men's and Ladies pairs events. The policy will be to advertise all the usual events and refund the entries where any event is not staged due to the need to allow heats in the fours events. Clubs will be advised – by E Mail - of any cancelled events within three days of the Regatta entries closing with written confirmation and refund of entry fees within a week - and a week before the regatta takes place
